WEEKLY CAMP PAYMENT

Hourly Care is available upon request on a space-available basis. Please contact the School Age Center for information on hourly care fees and reservations.

Fees are calculated by Parent Central Services at registration. Department of Defense Fee Application (DD Form 2652) is required to establish a fee payment category.

ADDITIONAL PROGRAM INFORMATION: Field Trips

Your child's grade for Villaggio Summer Camp enrollment is based on the grade they were in during the 2025-2026 school year, not the grade they will be in after the summer.

Field Trips will be scheduled on Tuesdays for 1st and 2nd graders, Thursdays for 3rd to 5th graders, or all grades on Thursdays. Outdoor play will be offered daily (weather permitting). If you wish for your child to wear sunscreen or insect repellent, please fill out a basic care form. Please take note that aerosol cans are NOT permitted in the center.

Please make sure to sign field trip permission slips as this is required for children to attend - NO exceptions. Children must be signed into the center 30 minutes prior to the scheduled bus departure time.

Parents are responsible for children who may not attend field trips or special outings due to behavior. Parents will be asked to pick up their child if they are having behavioral difficulties or posing a safety risk.

FIELD TRIPS

Field trips are scheduled on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Campers should arrive no later than 8:30 a.m. to prepare for the trip as the bus will depart promptly at 9:00 a.m.

Children may bring no more than 5 Euro spending money on each field trip unless otherwise specified prior to the trip.

Note: Children must wear summer camp t-shirts on field trip days. Field Trips and Camps are subject to change.

FIELD TRIP CHECKLIST

IMPORTANT CAMP INFORMATION

1. Registration

Current registration through CYS Parent Central Services is required to participate in summer camp.

2. Camp Fees

Fees are billed weekly and are due the Monday prior to the beginning of camp week. Failure to pay may result in the loss of your child's slot.

3. Dress Code

Appropriate clothing and shoes are worn at all times especially on field trips. **CLOSED-TOED AND CLOSED-HEELED SHOES ARE REQUIRED.** No flip-flops of any kind are permitted while at SAC due to safety hazards. Please ensure all items brought into the center are labeled with your child's first and last name. These items could include hats, water bottles, swimsuits, backpacks, towels, etc.

4. Food Policy

All outside food and beverages are prohibited in the center. Documentation of special dietary requirements is handled through Parent Central Services.

5. Medical & Special Needs

If your child requires medication, or has any special accommodations, additional documentation is required. A Multi Disciplinary Inclusion Action Team (MIAT) meeting may be required prior to starting CYS summer camps.

IMPORTANT CAMP INFORMATION

6. Field Trips

A signed permission slip is required for field trips and may be required for some specialty activities. Field trips are subject to change due to weather, availability, and program needs. Parents will receive permission slips in advance prior to activities requiring them. If you do not have the proper permission form, your child will not be able to participate—there are no exceptions.

7. Personal Property

CYS is NOT responsible for any lost or stolen items. We ask that all personal items be left at home such as electronics, cell phones, toys, gaming devices, etc.

8. Internet Use

CYS provides safe access to internet. Parents and/or guardians are responsible for the actions of their child(ren).

9. Behavior

In case of children continual misbehavior or not following adult instruction that leads to a disruption in the program; an incident report will be written, and will be shared with parents. Actions included are: using foul language fighting, inappropriate touching, leaving the supervised area without being accompanied by an adult, or intentional hurt another child,

PARENT & CHILD RESPONSIBILITIES

One of the goals of Villaggio SAC is to encourage children to experience independence by sharing responsibility with their parents.

1. Parents are responsible for providing sunscreen for their child. Children without sunscreen cannot participate in water play activities. Aerosol sunscreen is flammable and cannot be used in CYS programs.
2. Parents are responsible for swiping and signing their child(ren) in and out of the facility.
3. Parents must ensure their child is at the facility 30 minutes prior to the scheduled time of bus departure.
4. All camps, activities and fieldtrips are subject to change due to weather, availability and program requirements.
5. Parents must ensure all items brought in by their child are clearly labeled with the child's first and last name. This includes hats, water bottles, swim suits, backpack, towels, etc.
6. If your child cannot attend the field trip for his/her scheduled day- i.e, doctor's appointment, missed bus, etc. please let the front desk staff know. Children who miss the bus for a trip can stay at SAC and join in the activities for the day.
